

This outfit was easy to make. The fringe pieces are 4" long, Cut a bit of card board about $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches long [11cm] and wrap it a few times then cut one edge. Do this several times then tie the fringes and cut more as needed. When they are all tied, trim them evenly. I had the shirt sewn for me but have lost the seamstress's name, unfortunately. The hat came from the on-line AG store. Her string tie is yarn chain stitched and pinned with a lonely turquoise and silver earring from my jewelry box.

American Girl Cowgirl Outfit


Fits most 18" girl dolls — One skein Lion Brand Lion Suede, color Mocha

2x4 2x4 2x4 2x4 4x4 sleeve Leave bodice open between dots on side seams. Insert sleeve.

You could use two 2×2 sewn together to make the 2×4

Sew skirt together and firm into a tube. Thread round elastic though top loops, or leave backk deam open for 2" and crochet a waist band to fit her.
