## Tyler's Summer Dress

Baby yarn, fingering weight (I think)  
#2 dps

Inc 1: pick up and knit the stitch under the next  
stitch, knit next stitch.

Skirt:

Cast on 48, join

Knit 7 rows

\*K1 inc1\*

Knit 1 1/2inch (15cm)

\* k1 inc1\*

Knit 1 1/2" (15 cm)

Purl one row, knit one row, purl one row

Bind off

Bodice:

Pick up & knit 48 stitches from cast on.

\*K1, k2tog.\*

knit 4 rows

\*k4, k2tog.\* cast on 4 -for placket. (33 stitches) Turn.  
Working back and forth now.

K4 \*p\*

Knit

Repeat last two rows 7 times.

K 13, pm, inc in next stitch, k7, inc , k13.

K4, \*p\*, k4

Repeat last two rows for 4 increases.

K 13, k2 tog, k to next decrease and k 2 tog ( I forgot to count this so do it where ti looks  
right... sorry)



K4, \*p\*, k4

Repeat decrease row

Bind off.

To finish: Work reverse single crochet around hem and around top of bodice. Sew thin Velcro strip to placket to close. Or snaps, or, if you're clever and plan ahead, buttonholes and buttons.

I also made a petticoat of nylon net and stitched it to the underside of the skirt.

## Shrug

With same yarn as dress & #2 needles

cast on 14

Work k1,p1, rib for 4 rows.

Change to 'fur' yarn. I used Bernat Baby Lash but I think you could just continue with the cuff yarn and add a strand of FunFur eyelash, or use your choice of 'fur' or designer yarns.

Change to Size 8 needle (or whatever seems appropriate to your yarn)

Knit in garter stitch 12 rows

Cast off 7 stitches.

Knit 8 rows.

Cast on 7 stitches.

Knit 12 rows

Change back to #2's and baby yarn and work 4 rows k, p1 ribbing. Cast off.

You can modify this by making longer 'sleeves'. And it is easily changed to fit just about any doll. Try it on her as you go.
