2. W2, U3m O1 across, end W2
3. U3, O1 across, end U3.
4. Plain weave
5. W2, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W5, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W2.
6. Plain weave
7. U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W9, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3.
8. Plain weave
9. W2, U3, O1, U3, W13, U3, O1, U3, W2.
10. Plain weave
11. U3, O1, U3, W17, U3, O1, U3.
12. Plain weave
13. W2, U3, W21, U3, W2.
14. U3, O1, U3, W17, U3, O1, U3.

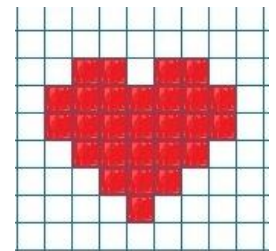
Now you reverse the pattern:

15. Plain Weave.
16. W2, U3, O1, U3, W13, U3, O1, U3, W2.
17. Plain weave.
18. U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W9, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3.
19. Plain weave.
20. W2, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W5, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W2.
21. Plain weave.
22. U3, O1 across, end U3.
23. W2, U3m O1 across, end W2.
24. Plain weave.

Here I've already added the small x-stitch heart but you can just leave yours plain. Without the motif, the block is reversible, the long stitches running horizontally.



Here is the heart and the valentine I made using this. I added the words and the bullion stitch flower and



pasted it onto a bit of fancy cut foil and then onto card stock to make the card.
