

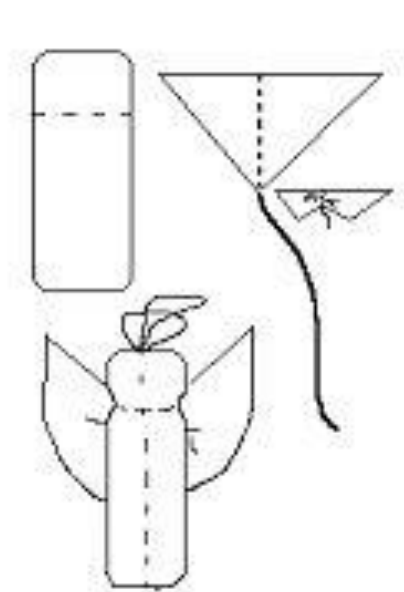
The Angel:

With your 4" Multi loom, warp one square with white and weave

about 5 rows with white and the rest with blue to make it's gown then sew the square into a tube. Gather one end tightly. Stuff and gather other end tightly*.

*The last couple I've made I stuffed the head and part way past the neck then left the bottom open. The neck gather stitch tightens around the stuffing and holds it in place. I think it looks more gown-like.

Run a gather stitch around the 'neck' and pull up slightly to form neck. Make another square or a triangle with white. (Use a double strand of worsted to make the wing if you are weaving with the Quilt Weaver). You want it rather stiff. Fold the square in half diagonally, slightly off centered, and run a gather stitch up the center as shown. Pull it up tightly, gathering the wing down the center. Sew the wing to the angel's back. You can make a halo from some gold thread or a chenille stem. Add a hanging loop and she's ready for your tree or wreath.



*With the Quilt Weaver, your square will be all one color.
